CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. R. CAIRNES and MRS. J. R. CAIRNES

of Route 1, Brownsville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooia River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16184 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 12, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.132 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M., as projected on James R. Templeton D.L.C. No. 52,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. No. 52,
4.1 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on D.L.C. No. 52,
Section 11,
Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning on the South line of and East 41.76 chains distant from the Southwest corner of the D.L.C. of James R. Templeton, Not. No. 2613 and Claim No. 52 in T. 14 S of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, and running from thence North 34.04 chains to the Calapooia River; thence South 56 $\frac{1}{4}$ ^o East up said river 1.83 chains; thence South 46^o East up said river 1.90 chains; thence South 50 $\frac{1}{4}$ ^o East up said river 3.14 chains; thence South 32^o East up said river 1.13 chains; thence South 28.73 chains to the South line of said Claim; and thence West 5.91 chains to the place of beginning, containing 18.71 acres.

(Said premises being the same premises conveyed by Frank D. Snyder and wife to said Winifred Wells by her then name of Winifred V. Snyder, by deed of date July 9, 1923, recorded July 25, 1923, at page 35 of Vol. 130 of the Deed Records of Linn County, Oregon. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
