for the purpose of the irrigation of 1840 acres of land, domestic, stock and storage

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of
Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,
in the Order Record of the Market BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at
page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1887
for the irrigation of 160 acres from Willow Creek; 1895 and 1904 for the irrigation of
1680 acres from Kern and Turner Creeks, and 1905 for storage from the waters of Spring
Branch, Sheep Corral, Currant and Kern Creeks.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 21.40 sec. ft. from February 15th to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 920 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

40 acres in NW_NE_1; 40 acres in NW_NW_1 of Section 6, Tp. 18 S. R. 45 E. W. M. 40 acres in NE_NW_2; 40 acres in NW_NW_2; 40 acres in SW_NW_2; 40 acres in SE_NW_2; 40 acres in SE_NW_2; 40 acres in SE_NW_2; 40 acres in NW_NW_2; 40 acres in SE_NW_2; 40 acres in NW_NW_2; 40 acres in NW_N

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
