## CERTIFICATE WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That J. A. HOSKINS

Oregon

has a right to the use of

the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Malheur River; Gum, Big Spring Creeks tributary to Willow Creek

for the purpose of the irrigation of 317.5 acres of land, domestic, stock, house, barn and orchard.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Ma lheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Research of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1873 for the irrigation of 142.5 acres; 1909 for the irrigation of 55 acres; 1883 for the irrigation of 120 acres from Willow and Gum Creeks and 1872 for domestic, house, barn and orchard from Big Spring Creek.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose's aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 7.94 sec. ft. from rebruary 15th to May 1st and 3.99 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to 0.05 sec. ft. for domestic, house, barn and orchard. exceed 952.5 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 19 acres in NE NE 38.2 acres in NW 1000 35.5. acres in SWANEA; 40 acres in SEANEA; 37.5 acres in NEASEA; 8.3 acres in NW4SE4: 8.5 acres in SE4SE4 of Section 9: 28.5 acres in SW4NW4: 38.5 acres in SW-SW-: 37 acres in NW-SW-: 26.5 acres in NESSW- of Section 10, Tp. 16 S. R. 43 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
