This Is to Certify, That GEO. E. MAC GINITIE

of Box 37, Corona Del Mar State of California , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Teal Creek

a tributary of Luckiamute River

for the purpose of

irrigation

Permit A-1-500-1-kg

under Permit No. 16636 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby October 23, 1945 confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET SWT, Section 27, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, W. M., as projected on Adam Brown D.L.C. No. 46,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre in SE NW2, as projected on D.L.C. No. 46, 1.5 acres in NE_4 SW_4 , as projected on D.L.C. No. 46, Section 27, Township 8 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 5.50 chains east and 43.70 chains north of the southwest corner of the Adam Brown DLC, thence north 12.30 chains, thence West 2.5 chains, thence south 12.30 chains, thence east to the point of beginning, and comprising 3.08 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
