CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. L. KENWORTHY

of Hoskins, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of domestic for one family and stock under Permit No. 16904 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 10 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 2,
T. 10 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows:
Beginning at a point 20 rods East of the half mile post between Sections 2 and 3, Township 10 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian, said point or place of beginning being in the middle of the Luckiamute River; thence East 140 rods; thence South 80 rods to the middle of said Luckiamute River; thence back the center of the said Luckiamute River as it now runs to the place of beginning, containing in all 35 acres, more or less, except 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres deeded to School District No. 68 of Polk County and recorded in Volume 80 at Page 596, of Polk County.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
