CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM YOUNG

of Route 1, Box 469, Ashland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring a tributary of Neil Creek Watershed, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of domestic for one family under Permit No. 18525 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 18, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 gallons per minute

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$,
Section 30,
T. 39 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Beginning at an iron pin 1140.9 feet South and 1086.9 feet East from the Northwest corner of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, in Township 39 South, of Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon, being a point on the Westerly line of tract described in Volume 5 Page 380 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon; thence South 88° 29' East 222.5 feet; thence South 1° 31' West 443.1 feet; thence North 51° 16' West 119.6 feet; thence North 41° 40' West 100.0 feet; thence North 28° 43' West 131.8 feet to the westerly line of said Tract; thence North 4° East 186.5 feet, along said westerly line, to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
