CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE TRASK

of Myrtle Creek , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation

under Permit No. 13332 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 15, 1938

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NET NWT, Section 25, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.0 acres in Lot 3 (NE¹/₄ NN¹/₄)
5.2 acres in Lot 4 (NN¹/₄ NN¹/₄)
3.2 acres in NN¹/₄ NN¹/₄, as projected on D.L.C. No. 47
0.6 acre in SE¹/₄ NN¹/₄,

T. 29 S., R. 5 W., W.M.

Lend on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: Iots 1 and 2 in Section 23, lot 5 in Section 24, Lot 4 in Section 25 lots 3, 4, 5 and 6 and the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter and the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 23, the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter and lots 3 and 4 of Section 24, the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and lot 3 of Section 25, the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter, the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 23, the North-half of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, excepting $7\frac{1}{2}$ acres lying on the South side of the County road; also that piece or parcel of land commencing 6 rods North and 11.95 chains east from the Southwest corner of Section 24, thence West 11 chains thence west of Southwest 10.80 chains, thence south 7.25 chains, thence East 19.50 chains, thence north 13.25 chains to the place of beginning containing 24 acres of land, more or less; also that certain piece or parcel of land beginning at a point 6 rods North of the Southwest corner of Section 24 thence running east 48 rods, thence North 34 rods, thence West 48 rods, thence South 34 rods to the place of beginning; also beginning at a point 5 chains East of the Southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 48 thence North 12.52 chains to the center of County Road thence Northwesterly along center of County Road to west line of said claim No. 48 thence South to the Southwest corner of Claim No. 48,

thence East 5 chains to the place of beginning containing 62 acres; also beginning at a point 6 chains East of the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 23 thence South 5° East 8.93 chains, thence South 7 3/4° West 11.29 chains, thence West to the center line of Section 23, thence North 20 chains to the Southwest corner of lot 2, thence East 6 chains to the place of beginning containing about 12½ acres except that portion of the above described lands heretofore conveyed to George E. Brewer; all of said lands being in Township 29 South of Range 5 West of Willamette Meridian, in Douglas County, Oregon; also excepting from the foregoing conveyance that certain piece or parcel of land heretofore conveyed to H. W. Jones the deed for which is recorded in Volume 63 of the Deed Records of Douglas County, at page 346 thereof; also excepting that certain piece or parcel of land heretofore conveyed by A.C. Marsters to G.E. Brewer the deed for which is recorded in Volume 51 of the Deed Records of Douglas County, Oregon at page 314 thereof; also excepting that certain tract or parcel of land, heretofore conveyed to N. G. Buell and F. G. Buell the deed for which is recorded in Volume 66 of Deed Records of Douglas County, Oregon, at page 303 thereof; also excepting any right—of—way or other easement belonging to the owners of that certain flume now extending across a certain portion of said premises which was built by W. P. Johnson and afterwards transferred to the Myrtle Lumber Company; and also excepting all easements for county roads across said premises.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforcsaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
