CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. S. and Miriam D. Baker of the County of Jackson State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 95 acres, and stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Jackson, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume: 4 I, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 190 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use) is as follows:

- 4 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4
- 8 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4
- 15 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4
- 38 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4
- 1 acre in SW 1/4 SW 1/4
- Section 33,
- 12 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4
- 17 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4
