for the purpose of the irrigation of 193 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State VITER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from Spring of 1872 for 40 acres and 1883 for 153 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 4.83 sec. ft. from February 15th to May 1st and 2.42 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 579 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 17.5 acres in NW1NE1: 35 acres in SW1NE1: 32 acres in NE1NW1: 30 acres in SE1NW1: of Section 24. 7.5 acres in NE1NW1: 16.5 acres in NW2NW1: 17 acres in SW1SW1: 37.5 acres in SE1SW2 of Section 13. Tp. 15 S., R. 42 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
