## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

for the purpose of Numicipal, Domestic, Stock and Irrigation purposes in Tract No. 1, and development of 600 horsepower in Tract No. 2 and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson.

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1854 for 0.18 cubic foot per round, 1861 for 5.0 cubic feet per second, 1862 for 1.0 cubic foot per second, 1872 for 2.50 cubic feet per second, 1882 for 1.0 cubic foot per second, in Tract No. 1; and 1854 for 7.00 cubic feet per second, 1868 for 14.50 cubic feet per second, 1889 for 7.50 cubic feet per second, in Tract No. 2 cubic feet per second, in the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 12.43 cubic feet per second in Tract No. 2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within the corporate limits of the City of Ashland, Jackson County, Oregon Power Claim # 552

## Tract No. 2

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
