has a right to the use of

the waters of Hug Creek or Spring, Miller, Shasta and Rich Creeks, tributary of Willow Creek and Willow Creek, a tributary of Malheur River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 305.5 acres of land, domestic, stock, supplemental supply and storage.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of County, and the said decree entered of record at Sulem, Malheur in the Order Record of the State Water Board of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at

page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1885 for the irrigation of 55.5 acres and storage; from Hug or Spring Creek; 1881 for the irrigation of 30 acres from Miller Creek; 1894 for the irrigation of 35 acres from Shasta Creek; 1897 for the irrigation of 60 acres from Rich Creek; 1868 for supplemental supply and irrigation of 125 acres from Willow Creek; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the

purpose a aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-

poses, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 7.66 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 3.83 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 916.5 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is us follows: From Hug or Springs: - 3 acres in SWANWA; 17 acres in SE1NW1; 7 acres in NW1NW1; 6 acres in NE1SW2; 17 acres in NW1SE1; 5.5 acres in SW1SE1 of Section 5, Tp. 14 S. R. 40 E. W. H., in Malheur County, Ocegon.

From Miller Creek - 20 acres in NE 1882; 10 acres in NW SE2 of Section 3. Tp. 14 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

From Shasta Creek- 30 acres in NE2SW2; 5 acres in NW2SW2 of Section 31. Tp. 13 S. R. 41 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

From Mich Creek- and supplemental supply from Willow Creek, 15 acres in SW1SE1; 30 acres in SE1SW1; 15 acres in SW2SW2 of Section 31, Tp. 13 S. R. 41 E. W. M. in Mal heur County, Oregon.

From Willow Creek- 25 acres in NE NE ; 30 acres in NW NE ; 30 acres in NE NW and 40 acres in NW NW of Section 6. Tp. 14 S. R. 41 E. W. H., in Malheur

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
