CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That JAMES MORFITT of Malheur State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Hug Creek or Spring, Miller, Shasta and Rich Creeks, tributary of Willow Creek and Willow Creek, a tributary of Malheur River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 305.5 acres of land, domestic, stock, supplemental supply and storage.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1885 for the irrigation of 55.5 acres and storage; from Hug or Spring Creek; 1881 for the irrigation of 30 acres from Miller Creek; 1894 for the irrigation of 35 acres from Shasta Creek; 1897 for the irrigation of 60 acres from Rich Creek; 1868 for supplemental supply and irrigation of 125 acres from Willow Creek; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 7.66 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 3.83 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 916.5 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

From Hug or Spring Creek:- 3 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4; 17 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4; 7 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4; 6 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4; 17 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4; 5.5 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 5, Tp. 14 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

From Miller Creek - 20 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4; 10 acres in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, Tp. 14 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

From Shasta Creek- 30 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4; 5 acres in NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, Tp. 13 S. R. 41 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

From Rich Creek- and supplemental supply from Willow Creek, 15 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4; 30 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4; 15 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 31, Tp. 13 S. R. 41 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

From Willow Creek- 25 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4; 30 acres in NW 1/4 NE 1/4; 30 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 40 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 6, Tp. 14 S. R. 41 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
