CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. S. Lynch

of Talent, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Wagner Creek, a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 25 acres, and Domestic and Stock

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1861;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.62 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Beginning at NW corner of Sec. 2, T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W. M., thence South 30 chains; thence east 30 chains, thence 30 chains north; thence west 30 chains to the place of beginning; also beginning 8 chains 80 links north of the SW corner of D. L. C. No. 37, Sec. 2, T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W. M., thence east 22 chains and 75 links; north 36 chains 20 links; west 22 chains 75 links; south 36 chains 20 links, to beginning.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
