CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. C. Ward

of Talent, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Wagner Creek, a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 8 acres, and Domestic and Stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1861;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8 acres of the following described premises: Beginning at the SE corner Section 2, T. 39 S., R. 1 W., W. M., thence West 13 chains; South 20 chains; West 7 chains; North 15 chains; East 5 chains to Wagner Creek; thence along creek northwesterly to where it intersects South line of D. L. C. No. 37, said T. and R., thence East 2.25 chains; North 11.75 chains; East 25 chains; South 20 chains, to place of beginning, containing 65 1/2 acres of land.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
