## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is in Certify, That CLARENCE H. OXMAN AND FRANK C. OXMAN, Jr of Vale State of Cregon has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Malheur River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 389.5 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State with the Order Record of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5 at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1871 for 200 acres and 1873 for 189.5 acres

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes; and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 9.74 sec. ft. from belowary 15th to May 1st and 4.87 sec.ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 1168.5 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
