that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 3.60 sec. ft. from rebruary 15th to May 1st and 1.80 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 432 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 30 acres in NE2SE2 of Section 31, 25 acres in NW2SW2: 35 acres in SW2SW2: 24 acres in SE2SW2: 30 acres in SW2SE2 of Section 32
