of Malheur State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Raceby Creek, a tributary of Willow Creek,

for the purpose of the irrigation of 40 acres of land, domestic and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Sulem, in the Order Record of the State WATER BOALD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from the year 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 1.00 sec.ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 0.50 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 120 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 5 acres in NW182; 10 acres in NE182; 5 acres in NW182; of Section 26, Tp. 13 S. R. 40 E. W. M., 6 acres in NW182; 5 acres in SE182; of Section 14 and 5 acres in NE182; of Section 23, Tp. 13 S. R. 40 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
