## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Theo. J. Fish

, State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Coleman Creek, a tributary of Bear Creek

for the purpose of irrigation of 20 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1880;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

> 1h acres in NE 4 SE 4 6 acres in SE SE Section 16, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Note: This Certificate conforms to an order of the State Engineer dated November 6th, 1924, for the correction of an error in the description of lands.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
