CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Den Cameron :

, State of Oregon , has a right to the use of

the waters of Pleasant Creek, a tributary of Evans Creek

for the purpose of Mining, Nov. 1st to June 1st, in Tract No. 1, irrigation of 3 acres in Tract No. 2, and Mining, Nov. 1st to June 1st, in Tract No. 3 and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1860 for Tract No. 1, 1862 for Tract No. 2, and 1861 for Tract

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.00 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 1, 0.08 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2, and 5.00 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 3.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1

(See Note in Decree) Placer mines located in Sections 15, 22 and 27, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Tract No. 2

3 acres in SEA NWA Section 22, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

Tract No. 3

Placer mines located in Sections 22 and 28, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
