CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Lone Star Mining Company

of Rogue River, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek, a tributary of Evans Creek for the purpose of Mining, Nov. 1st to June 1st,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from Mar. 27, 1900 for Tract No. 1, and 1893 for Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 15.00 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 1, and 10.00 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 2;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
