that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 1.73 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 0.87 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year; or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 207 acre feet.
