CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That A. H. Quatman

of Willows, Glenn County, State of California, has a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek, a tributary of Evans Creek

for the purpose of irrigation of 36 acres in Tract No. 1, and mining in Tract No. 2, Nov. 1st to June 1st, and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1875;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.60 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 1, and 12.50 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right; and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:
