

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Charles Williams, Estate of,

of Rogue River

State of Oregon

, has a right to the use of

the waters of Ditch Creek, a tributary of Pleasant Creek.

for the purpose of irrigation of 84.59 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson

County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1877;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.28 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

14.39 acres in SW1 SW1 Section 28,
21.69 acres in NW1 NW1 17.72 acres in SW1 NW1 21.56 acres in SE1 NW1 Section 33,
0.58 acres in SE1 NE1 8.65 acres in NE1 NE1 Section 32,

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
