of Vale State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Malheur River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 290.4 acres, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State 10,187 of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1877 for 140 acres; 1883 for 60 acres and 1905 for 90.4 acres.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose s aforesuid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose s, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 7.26 sec. ft. from February 15th to May 1st and 3.63. sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 871.3 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenunt, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 24.9 acres in NW\_SE\_1. 12.5 acres in SW\_SE\_2; 35 acres in NE\_SE\_2; 38 acres in SE\_SE\_2 of Section 25 and 35 acres in NE\_SE\_2 of Section 36, Tp. 16 S. R. 43 E. W. M., 32 acres in SE\_SW\_2; 38 acres in NW\_SW\_2; 40 acres in SW\_SE\_2 of Section 30, Tp. 16 S. R. 44 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesuid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
