CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Elmer E. Bagley

of Ashland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Wards Creek, a tributary of Rogue River.

for the purpose of Mining, Nov. 1st to May 1st, in Tracts Nos. 1 and 2, and irrigation of 25 acres in Tract No. 3 and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1901 for Tracts Nos. 1 and 2, and 1889 for Tract No. 3;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.5 cubic feet per second in Tract No. 1, 2.5 cubic feet per second in Tract No. 2, and 0.42 cubic foot per second in Tract No. 3.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Placer mines in W 1/2 SE 1/4

4 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4
18 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4
3 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 12,
T. 36 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
