of Dell State of Tregon has a right to the use of the waters of Willow Creek, a tributary of Malheur River

for the purpose of their rigation of 32 acres of land, domestic and stock use,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 3, at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1877;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purpose 8 aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose 8, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 0.80 sec. ft. from rebruary 15th to may let and 0.40 sec. ft. from May let to September let of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 96 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 7 acres in NELNWL, 25 acres in NELNWL of Section 32. Tp. 15 S. R. 43 E. W. M., in Mal heur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
