## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Golden Standard Mining Co.

of Jacksonville, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Galls Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, and Alder Gulch, a tributary of Galls Creek for the purpose of Mining and Milling, continuous use, in Tract No. 1, and irrigation of 2 acres in Tract No. 2, from Galls Creek; and supplemental supply from Alder Gulch, and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4 at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1860 for Tract No. 1, 1901 for Tract No. 2, and 1860 for supplemental supply from Alder Gulch;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 1, and 0.05 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2, from all sources, subject to the provisions of paragraph 79 of said decree;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1

Gold bearing quartz claims  
in Section 32,  
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

and Sections 5 and 6,  
T. 37 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Tract No. 2

2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33,  
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
