and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the State VATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 5 at page 258; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1868;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesuid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 2.75 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 1.38 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 330 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water bereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 35 acres in NE_NE_1: 15 acres in NW_NE_1: 30 acres in SW_NE_2: 10 acres in SW_NE_1: and 20 acres in SE_NW_2 of Section 1. Tp. 14 S., R. 40 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.
