that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of flow of 2.60 sec. ft. from April 1st to May 1st and 1.31 sec. ft. from May 1st to September 1st of each year, or the equivalent in case of rotation; the total quantity diverted during each irrigation season not to exceed 312 acre feet.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 33 acres in NENE; 17 acres in NENE; 10 acres in SENE; 17 acres in SENE; cf Section 35, Tp. 14 S. R. 38 E. W. M., in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesuid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
