CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. H. Taylor

of Ruch, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Little Applegate River, a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation of 19 acres, and Domestic and Stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from September 1, 1857;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

19 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

Note: This Certificate conforms to the provisions of a decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County dated April 19th, 1928, in conformity with Mandate of Supreme Court.
