## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That Carl J. Schmidt

of Buncom, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Yale Creek, or Right Fork of Little Applegate River, and supplemental supply from Quartz Gulch, a tributary of Yale Creek, for the purpose of irrigation of 25 acres and Domestic and Stock use from Yale Creek, and supplemental supply for irrigation of 18 acres of said 25 acres and Domestic and Stock use from Quartz Gulch, and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for Yale Creek, and 1903 for Quartz Gulch;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.63 cubic foot per second from Yale Creek, and 0.45 cubic foot per second for supplemental supply from Quartz Gulch, but not to exceed 0.63 cubic foot per second from both sources, subject to the provisions of paragraph 79 of said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

25 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 4,  
T. 40 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
