## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. K. Miller

of Leland, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Brimstone Gulch, a tributary of Grave Creek; and supplemental supply from Haydes Gulch, a tributary of Brimstone Gulch, for the purpose of Mining, Oct. 1 to June 1

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1896 for Brimstone Gulch, and 1897 for Haydes Gulch;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.00 cubic feet per second from Brimstone Gulch, and supplemental supply of 3.00 cubic feet per second from Haydes Gulch, but not to exceed 3.00 cubic feet per second from both sources, subject to the provisions of paragraph 79 of said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
