## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That Old Channel Mining Company, a corporation, and J. R. Harvey, tenants in common, of Grants Pass, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of

the waters of Right or North Fork Galice Creek (also known as West Fork) including Mill Creek, Quartz Creek, Blanchard Creek, Applegate Creek, and Tributaries, and Rice Gulch, a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of Hydraulic Placer Mining in Tract No. 1, and Development of 8.5 horsepower in Tract No. 2 and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 75.00 cubic feet per second for Tract No. 1, and 1.00 cubic foot per second for Tract No. 2.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1

Old Channel Placer Mines  
in Tps. 34 and 35 S., R. 8 W., W. M.,  
(unsurveyed), in Galice Creek  
Mining District, Josephine County,  
Oregon.

Tract No. 2

Power developed to operate Sawmill  
and lighting plant on above  
described premises.

Note: The quantity of water used for power, in Tract No. 2, conforms to Annual Statement of Water Power Claimant filed by John R. Harvey, pursuant to provisions of Section 119-302, O.C.L.A., in which Statement the quantity of water has been reduced from 2.00 cubic feet per second to 1.00 cubic foot per second.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
