CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. L. Helms and Lulu Helms (Successors to Cary V. Loosley) of Rt. 1, Box 58, Tule Lake, State of California, has a right to the use of the waters of Fort Creek, a tributary of Wood River for the purpose of Irrigation

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 14, at page 442; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1902;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/50th of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated prior to July 20th, and 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre irrigated thereafter, and shall not exceed 5 acre feet per acre during irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

14.3 acres in Lot 6
 11.0 acres in Lot 7
 2.7 acres in Lot 8
 Section 34,
 T. 33 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., W. M.
 15.2 acres in N $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 3,
 T. 34 S., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
