CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That H. E. WINTER

of Scio, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Thomas Creek

a tributary of South Santiam River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 14520 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from August 3, 1940

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.028 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightlieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acres in the NW 1NW 1

Section 17

1.5 acres in the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, as projected on Preston Munkers D.L.C. Section 18

T. 10 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on a line between Section 17 and 18 distant 10.61 chains South of the Nordwest corner of Section 17 in Township 10, South of Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Linn County, Oregon, an running thence South 10 chains to the center of Thomas Creek thence following the courses of said stream East 7.50 chains, thence North 15° East 8 chains thence North 36° West 6 chains, thence West 1 chains; thence South 69° West 5 chains, to the place of beginning containing 10.67 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
