CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALBERT C. GREENER

of Route 5, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 14778 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 3, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.01 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Abram Sulger D.L.C. No. 61 and Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67, Section 16, Township 1 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.9 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Abram Sulger D.L.C. No. 61
- 0.4 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Abram Sulger D.L.C. No. 61
- 15.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Abram Sulger D.L.C. No. 61
- 11.1 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67
- 37.3 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67
- 39.7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67
- 24.7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67
- 2.8 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Abram Sulger D.L.C. No. 61
- 1.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67
- 20.4 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Henry Nowland Sr., D.L.C. No. 67

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 16, T1S, R2W of the Will. Mer., and running thence North along the section line to the Northwest corner of the Henry Nolan, Sr., Donation Land Claim No. 67; thence South 88° 28' East along the North line of said claim a distance of 25.12 chains to the Northeast corner of said claim; thence continuing South 88° 28' East to the center of the Tualatin River; thence following down the center of said River, with all the meanderings thereof to the South line of said Section 16; thence West along said South line to the place of beginning, being part of the Henry Nolan, Sr., Donation Land Claim, No. 67 and part of the Abram Sulger Donation Land Claim No. 61 in said Township and Range; Also the following tract being part of the Russell Holbrook Donation Land Claim No. 62 in Township 1 S R 2 W of the Will. Mer: Beginning

at a point on the East line of said Donation Land Claim No. 62, distant South 8.48 chains from the quarter section corner between Sections 16 and 17, in said Township 1 S R 2 W of the Will. Mer.; running thence South 10.74 chains; thence West 8.32 chains; thence North $37 \frac{3}{4}^\circ$ East 13.58 chains to the place of beginning; Also that portion of the North half of the claim No. 67 of Henry Nolan, Sr., lying in the North half of Section 21, T1S, R2W of the Will. Mer., described as follows: Beginning at a point South $89^\circ 21'$ East 1380 feet from the Northwest corner of said Section 21; thence South $30^\circ 29'$ East 377.3 feet; thence South $48^\circ 45'$ East 297.6 feet; thence South $75^\circ 41'$ East 297.2 feet; thence North $72^\circ 41'$ East 143.3 feet; thence North $63^\circ 05'$ East 208.8 feet; thence north $33^\circ 56'$ East 149.1 feet; thence North $14^\circ 30'$ East 338.0 feet; thence South $89^\circ 59'$ East 500 feet; thence South $67^\circ 39'$ East 249.6 feet to the center line of the Tualatin River, thence following the center line of said River to the North line of said Sec. 21, thence West to the place of beginning; Subject to right of way as conveyed to the Oregon Central Railroad Company by deed recorded in Book H, page 568 and an easement granted to the Oregon Iron & Steel Co by deed recorded in Book T at page 477, and now subject to the rights of way for public roads as same now exist, all records of Washington County, Ore.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
