CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JONAS M. WILL AND GUSSIE M. WILL

of Aurora, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 11,816 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 26, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.093 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, Township 4 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

6.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
1.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 12

T. 4 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section Thirteen (13) T. 4 S. R. 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon; thence North 11.64 chains to the center of the County road leading to Butteville; Thence North 79-3/4° East along said road 23.83 chains; Thence South 15-1/2° West 13 chains; Thence South 80° East 3.82 chains; Thence South 15-1/2° West 8.85 chains to a small fir tree; Thence South 53-1/2° West 2.36 chains; Thence North 65° West 10 chains to a Dogwood tree six inches in diameter; Thence North 31-1/2° West 3 chains; Thence West 9.50 chains to the place of beginning and containing 35 acres of land more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
