CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WORLD WAR VETERANS' STATE AID COMMISSION
AND MERRITT W. SAUNDERS

of Richland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of - - - for the purpose of

domestic use for two families under Permit No. 14893 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 29, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 9 South, Range 45, East of the Willamette Meridian; thence East 40 rods, thence Southwesterly along and parallel with the Waterbury and Allen Ditch to a point where the said ditch crosses the South boundary line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, thence West 16 rods to the Southwest Corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 22, thence North 80 rods to the place of beginning. Also, the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 45, East of the Willamette Meridian. All of said lands being situated in Eagle Valley, Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
