CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. H. BRULE' BY (MRS.) FERN G. BRULE'

of 57 N. Monte Celo Ave. Sierra Madre, State of California, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Elk Mt. Creek a tributary of Winchuck River for the purpose of domestic use for one family under Permit No. 15067 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 25, 1941

; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, Township 41 South, Range 12 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 5
T. 41 S., R. 12 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point which is situated 149.8 feet North and 910.6 feet East of the government one-quarter section corner common to Section Five and Eight in Township 41 South of Range 12 West, W.M.; thence North 79 deg. 41 min. West, 208.7 feet; thence North 10 degrees 19 minutes East 208.7 feet thence South 79 degrees 41 minutes East. 208.7 feet; thence South 10 degrees 19 minutes West, 208.7 feet to the point of beginning and containing one acre, more or less according to this survey thereof. Wood and water for life. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all their estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
