**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** ELMONT E. ROCKWELL

of Route 4, Box 247, Sherwood, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Chicken Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15068 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 26, 1941

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, Township 2 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 25  
T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter of Sec. #25 T. 2. S. R. 2 W. of the Willamette Meridian, running thence West along Section line, 22 rods, Thence South 80 rods, thence East 22 rods, Thence North along the Half Section line 80 rods to the place of beginning containing 11 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
