**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** MATH M. GASS

of Cloverdale, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Big Nestucca River for the purpose of domestic use for one family under Permit No. 15610 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 27, 1943

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 21

Domestic in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 22

T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the quarter section corner between sections 21 and 22, in Township 4 S., Range 10 W., of the Willamette Meridian, and running thence South 24° West 257.6 feet; thence South 87° 28' East 194.5 feet; thence South 20° 37' East 1598.9 feet to the right bank of the Big Nestucca River; thence following the said river downstream South 72° 33' West 496.3 feet; thence South 82° 10' West 205.4 feet; thence South 55° 49' West 337.5 feet; thence North 15° 40' West 2172.6 feet; thence North 89° 01' East 889.9 feet to the place of beginning, containing 41.93 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
