**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** JOHN MARKLUND

of Route 2, Box 269, Oregon City, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed spring, tributary of Cleer Creek a tributary of Clackamas River for the purpose of domestic use for one family under Permit No. 15715 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 22, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 1, Township 3 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic use in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 1

T. 3 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at the one-quarter corner between Sections One and Thirty-Six, Township Two South, Range Two East of the Willamette Meridian and Township Three South, Range 2 East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence South 35 chains Thence East 20 chains; thence North 5.00 chains; thence West 10.00 chains; thence North 30.00 chains; thence West 10.00 chains to the place of beginning, containing 40.00 acres, more or less, except therefrom 1 acre of land now used and occupied as a cemetery, and except public roads.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
