CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W. E. INGLE

of Rt. 16, Box 100, Milwaukie, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Kellogg Creek a tributary of Kellogg Creek, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15860 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 14, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.018 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Elisha Kellogg D.L.C. No. 4 Section 6, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Elisha Kellogg D.L.C. No. 54
Section 6
T. 2 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Being a part of the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. No. 54 in T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of the W. M. Clackamas County, Oregon, bounded and described as follows to-wit: Beginning at a point in the South boundary of the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. No. 54 in T. 2 S. R. 2 E. of the W. M. which point is S. 89° 41' E. 150.00 feet distant from the S. W. corner of said claim - Running thence S. 89° 41' E. tracing the south boundary of said claim 150.00 feet; thence N. 9° 04' W. parallel with the West boundary of the Elisha Kellogg D. L. C. aforesaid 933.90 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 89° 41' W. 150.00 feet to an iron pipe thence S. 0° 14' E. 933.90 feet to the place of beginning, containing 3.2159 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

G. HARVEY NAGLE: Beginning at a point on the West boundary of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 26 South, Range 14 West of Willamette Meridian, a distance of 182.0 feet South from the Northwest corner of the said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 2:- and running thence South for a distance of 94.0 feet; thence East parallel to the North boundary of the said Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 2 for a distance of 1010.0 feet to a point on the West boundary of the unvacated portion of Mitchell Street in the Townsite of Seaport, Plat "A", Coos County, Oregon, according to the map and plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of the said County; thence North along the said boundary of Mitchell Street for a distance of 94.0 feet; thence West for a distance of 1010.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.18 acres, more or less. Also:- beginning at a point 204.0 feet South and 250.0 feet West of the iron pipe at the center of Section 2, Township 26 South, Range 14 West of Willamette Meridian and running thence South for a distance of 72.0 feet; thence East for a distance of 100.0 feet; thence North for a distance of 72.0 feet; thence West for a distance of 100.0 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.165 acres, more or less, containing in all 2.345 acres, more or less, and being portions of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 2, Township 26 South, Range 14 West of Willamette Meridian.
