CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN E. PORTER

of Philomath, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Baker Creek a tributary of Alder Creek of N. Fork Alsea River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 15873 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 25, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, Township 13 South, Range 7 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

3.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 21

5.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28

T. 13 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: The South Half of the Southwest quarter of Section 21; the North Half of the Northwest Quarter, and a square containing 4 acres in the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28; also a tract of land 100 feet East and West by 200 feet North and South in the Northeast corner of Section 29; all in Township 13 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
