CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEORGE AND INA UPDEGRAFF

of Box 76, Dillard, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of $\frac{1}{2}$ acre garden under Permit No. 15939 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 3, Township 29 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre and domestic in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Robert Phipps DLC No. 37 Section 3 T. 29 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beg. at SE cor. of the R. R. Phipps D. L. C. No. 37 T 29 S/R 6 W W.M, th. S. 364.3' to cen. S. Umpqua River, th. S 79°-27' W 218.5' down cen. S. Umpqua River thence W. 284.7' down cen. S. Umpqua River, thence North 1080.6' to Pacific Hy. R/W. thence S 71°-41' E 525.9' along S. R/W line Pac. Hy. thence South 511.0' along the E. Line said D.L.C. 37 to the beginning containing 11.4 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
