**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** HARRY C. AND EDNA E. WALKER

of 317 S. James Ave., Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek a tributary of Pudding River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16086 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 1, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.063 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on James Brown D.L.C. No. 47, Section 34, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected on James Brown D.L.C. No. 47  
4.0 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) as projected on Thos. L. Coon D.L.C. Section 34

T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the N. line of McClaine Street, in the City of Silverton, Marion County, Oregon a distance of 246 feet more or less from James Street; thence in a N. E. direction along the N. line of McClaine Street a distance of 109 feet more or less to a point; thence by the same, a distance of 110 feet more or less to corner of land of J. M. Brown estate; thence by land of J. M. Brown estate in a N. E. Direction, a distance of approximately 275 feet more or less to land of Harry Walker; thence S. 86° 30' W. along land of Harry Walker a distance of 110 feet more or less to a point; thence by same, S. 73° W. a distance of approximately 170 feet more or less to corner of Harry Walker and G. S. Ackley; thence by land of G. S. Ackley, in a S. direction of 231 feet more or less to place of beginning.

Also, beginning at a point on the N. line of McClaine Street in the City of Silverton, Marion County, Oregon a distance of 99.67 feet from the most S. E. corner of tract #1; thence along N. line of McClaine Street a distance of 120 feet more or less to corner of W. A. Brandt; thence in a N. direction by land of H. A. Brandt approximately 320 feet to land of Harry Walker; thence by land of Harry Walker S. 86° 30' West 77.54 feet to corner of J. M. Brown estate; thence in a S. direction by land of J. M. Brown estate approximately 300 feet to point of beginning.

Also, commencing at a point which is 3.50 chains South of the Southwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of James Brown and wife, in Township Six (6) South, Range One (1) West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, State of Oregon; thence North 73 degrees East 6.00 chains; thence North 86 degrees 30' East 6.45 chains to the West boundary of a tract of land deeded to Emma Buff on the 3rd day of April, 1897; thence following down the channel of Silver Creek along the Westerly ends of

the above-named tract, and also the tracts deeded to Henry Allen on December 6th, 1901, to Minnie Sacry on August 27th, 1889, and to W. P. Potter on August 18, 1897 to the South boundary of the right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Railroad Company a distance of about 5.80 chains; thence Southwesterly along the Southerly side of said right-of-way 9.80 chains, more or less, to the West boundary of the Donation Land Claim of Thomas L. Coon and wife; thence South 2.06 chains, more or less, to the place of beginning; being situated in the Thomas L. Coon and the James Brown Donation Land Claims, in Township 6 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Marion County, Oregon.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
