CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FORD HARVEY

of Idanha , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Dry Creek a tributary of North Bantiam River for the purpose of log pond, cooling Diesel and domestic use for one family under Permit No. 16120 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 6, 1944

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.42 cubic foot per second, being 0.41 cubic foot per second for pond and Diesel and 0.01 cubic foot per second for domestic use.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE_4^1 NW_4^1 , Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 6 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic use, manufacturing and log pond in NW1 NW1 Domestic use and log pond in SW1 NW1 Section 17

T. 10 S., R. 6 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the south line of the Southern Pacific R.R. right-of-way which is South 102°C feet and South 64° 18'E. 100 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 17 in Township 10 South, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; thence running South 64° 18'East 987 feet along said right of way to the East end of the railroad bridge across Dry Creek; thence South 800 feet to the North Santiam River; thence down stream along said North Santiam river to a point due South of the beginning point; thence North 600 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
