CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That D. G. AND ELLEN GLENN

of Kernville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

an unnamed stream, a tributary of Siletz River, for the purpose of

domestic use in Auto Camp, including the irrigation of a right to exceed 1 acre garden under Permit No. 16201 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 6, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 8, Township 8 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

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and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 8
Domestic in Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 17
T. 8 S., R. 10 W., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the south boundary of the Siletz River Highway that is one thousand six hundred ninety-nine and three tenths feet east and ninety and nine tenths feet north of the north corner of sections seventeen and eighteen, township eight south of range ten west of the Willamette Meridian; running thence easterly along the south boundary of highway five hundred twenty-eight and five tenths feet to the west boundary of the Walter Kolbe property; thence south along the Koble property fifty feet to the north bank of the Siletz River; thence southwesterly along the Siletz River to the mouth of a small creek which is south 13° 18' east two hundred fifty-five feet from the place of beginning; thence up center of said creek to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
