CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MYRTLE E. FREY, OWNER
BY R. C. START, OPERATOR

of Ganby, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Molalla River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 16246 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 31, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.098 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Champing Pendleton D.L.C. No. 58, Section 29, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.8 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Champing Pendleton D.L.C. No. 58 Section 29

T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point 742.50 feet West of the Quarter Post between Sections 28 and 29, Township 3 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence South 1058 feet; thence West 343.7 feet; thence North 1058 feet; thence East 343.7 feet to the place of beginning, containing 8.35 acres more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
