CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JACK E. JOHNSON AND EVELYN L. JOHNSON

of Route 1, Oswego, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Willamette River, for the purpose of irrigation, under Permit No. 15265 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 10, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.016 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Gabriel Walling D.L.C. No. 63, Section 13, Township 2 South, Range 1 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.3 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected on Gabriel Walling D.L.C. No. 63
Section 13
T. 2 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of the property more explicitly described by the appropriator as follows: Beginning at a point on the Easterly line of County Road, South 24° 49' East, 103.34 feet from the Southwest corner of Lot 16, Holly Acres, according to the recorded plat, in Clackamas County, Oregon, and running thence, North 65° 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' East 179.43 feet to an iron pipe in the most Westerly corner of Lot 22 of plat of Holly Acres, thence North 54° 21' East. 71.9 feet to an iron pipe; thence, North 38° 58' East, 158.9 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 78° 41' East, 29.05 feet to an iron pipe; thence, North 56° 43' West, 263.46 feet to an iron pipe; thence South 57° 52' 40" West, 285.28 feet to an iron pipe on the Easterly line of aforesaid County road; thence South 24° 49' East, 262.99 feet to place of beginning, containing 2 $\frac{23}{100}$ acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
